**RE: Hutzler Kennel Special Exception**

Dear Mr. & Mrs. Hutzler,

We have reviewed the special exception request submitted to the Hamilton County Surveyor's Office on July 18, 2012, for this project and have the following comments:

1. The proposed project falls in the unincorporated area and MS4 jurisdiction of Hamilton County.
2. The proposed project DOES NOT fall in a Westfield Wellhead Protection Zone.
3. The proposed project falls in the Little Eagle Creek and Johnson & Gardner Regulated Drain Watersheds.
4. Under the Phase II requirements of the United State Clean Water Act, the law requires no detrimental impact of water quality that enters lakes, rivers, and streams. Pet waste is a large contributor of e-coli in our water bodies and is a pollutant of concern, since Little Eagle Creek is already rated as impaired for high e-coli levels. Please submit a written plan or building design drawings that describe or show how the pet waste is going to be managed from the commercial kennel operation. The kennel waste management plan will be reviewed and kept on file to future verification of compliance with the submitted plan.
5. With pending approval of the kennel waste management plan, the Hamilton County Surveyor's Office has no concerns with the proposed special exception request.
