GRAND PARK SPORTS CAMPUS UPDATE

As Spring arrives, construction at the Grand Park Sports Campus will see an increase in activity. Most of the below ground work is now completed and over the course of the last couple months, two packages have been put out for bid.

Phase III bid package included synthetic turf for 15 fields, four football goals, perimeter fencing and field fencing.

Phase IV bid package included all baseball dugouts, all 18 grass baseball fields, netting, lighting, stoning of multi-use paths on the baseball side of the project and a pedestrian bridge over Cool Creek.


During the next couple weeks, work at the Grand Park Sports Campus will

focus on the installation of the pedestrian tunnel. The tunnel will allow pedestrians to walk from the baseball side of the park to the soccer side without having to cross the park's main thoroughfare.

Looking ahead, crews will be finishing setting and back-filling the tunnel. Weather permitting, concrete work will continue on the pump house foundations.

It's exciting to think we are only a year away from full scale operation!

RULE THE ROAD - A TEENAGE DRIVING EVENT



On Saturday, May 18, 2013, from 10am to 3pm, the Westfield Police Department is hosting a teenage driving safety event called Rule the Road.

Specifically targeted toward teens ages 15-18 who are about to, or have recently

received their driver's license, Rule the Road gives teens the unique opportunity to learn the skills they need to keep them safe behind the wheel. Sponsored by the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute, Indiana SADD and the Westfield Police Department, these events allow young drivers to get valuable hands-on driving experience with certified emergency vehicle operators.

Registered participants will learn hazard recognition, vehicle handling, speed management and space management while using police vehicles. On-site activities include an impaired driving course, distracted driving simulator, food and giveaways.

A session focused on preventing crashes through proper vehicle maintenance will also be offered. During this session, led by a mechanic, students will learn how to change a tire, how to check tire pressure, plus other maintenance work. Students will have an opportunity to practice these skills hands on.

WORKZONE SAFETY

The City of Westfield would like to remind motorists to drive cautiously and obey posted speed limits as construction begins on several road projects around the City. Generally, road work is done during off-peak hours to ensure safety and maintain traffic flow. However, there are times when road work is necessary during high traffic times. Westfield street crews and contractors are required to use a flagger, signal person and wear high visibility safety apparel and protective equipment. FIELD NOTES

HYDRANT FLUSHING BEGINS THIS MONTH



The Westfield Public Works Department (WPWD) announced that biannual fire hydrant flushing will get underway again beginning April 8 and ending May 4. WPWD is urging all residents to be aware of the flushing in their respective areas and that temporary water discoloration could be a possible result.

Hydrant flushing is required periodically to scour the distribution system water mains. Flushing will occur between the hours of 10pm and 6am. During this process, WPWD crews will be working to remove particulate matter (Iron and Manganese) that subsequently builds up in the water mains. Removing these substances ensures that the cleanest water possible is provided to all residents.

WPWD urges its customers to minimize water usage during the hours of 10pm and 6am to minimize the potential of receiving discolored water. Activities such as laundry and cooking should not be conducted during those hours.
