


## Westfield Fire Department 2013 Incident Statistics By Fire / Medical Groups




### Westfield Fire Department 2012 Total Incidents

### Westfield Fire Department 2013 Incidents by Fire/Medical





■ City - Incidents ■ Township - Incidents ■ Out Of Twp - Assists




