Brian Zaiger presented this item stating that it is an investment policy outlining how funds are to be managed from the proceeds of the Utility Sale. Jim Crawford drafted the policy following the statutes with understanding there will be additional changes made before this is presented for adoption. Brian suggested that a meeting between Council and Jim Crawford be set up for chance to express concerns and answer any questions that there may be. One of the items to be addressed, being who has the ultimate fiscal control.

Ordinance 13-33: Stormwater Fee Schedule

Adoption Consideration – December 9, 2013

Todd Burtron presented this item stating this Ordinance deals with drainage issues throughout the community. There would be an increase of \$3.24/month billed quarterly to help offset areas recently annexed which have not had appropriate drainage/sewage issues met. Mayor Cook stated fees would also help in fixing of “high water” areas within the City. Steve Hoover suggested the customer be given an explanation of the new billing cycle and increase. Cindy Spoljaric also mentioned some word clarification changes that she would like made involving explanation of transfer of ownership.
