Dear Jennifer,

As a follow-up to my voice mail and in light of the pending petitions Docket No. 1404-DP-07 and 1404-SSP-05, please find attached a picture of an increasingly severe stormwater issue in front of our home at 15209 Oak Ridge Rd. (the brick ranch in the photos). This picture was taken at approximately 6 p.m. on 2/20. We have resided in our home for close to 12 years. During this time the flooding issue during heavy-to-moderate rain events and large snow melt events has inched closer and closer to our home. We understand this flooding is caused by a large culvert running under Oak Ridge Rd. to a smaller culvert running the length of our property in the public right-of-way to an open ditch in front of our neighbor's to the south. Basically the rate of water cannot keep up from the larger roadway culvert to the smaller front of property culvert. There is always continuous water flow, but water quantity is exceeding culvert capacity. We have no history on when the front of property culvert was installed.

I can only imagine what it looks like after this morning's heavy rains as I sit at work.

As I've stated, this flooding is getting closer and closer to our home. The elevation from where the flooding ends in these pictures to our house is extremely minimal. The front section of our driveway becomes an overflow to the neighboring ditch which will eventually be of detriment to the integrity of our driveway and to our street access. Finally, it hinders any landscaping improvements in our front yard as well as the health of the large tree that remains (as seen as an island in the pictures).

We ask that you please investigate this situation and provide comments. We are open to meeting with you on-site if necessary.
