I must say I am more than unimpressed with the Haven elevations. As shown, it looks akin to a prison to me. Colors, overall lack of detail or interest, lack of window treatments, insufficient roof treatment to elongate appearance of box-shaped building. Very uninviting. In my opinion, many standards required are not met in submitted elevations. Given the geographic location of the project and its importance in the park, I think this does a disservice and sets a tone for low expectation for future projects in the area. I would hope revised elevations are mandated. Thank you for considering my comments in advance of your meeting.
