

Bid Award- 147th Street and Greyhound Pass Intersection Improvements Contract

The Westfield Public Works Department accepted bids for the 147th Street and Greyhound Pass Intersection Improvements on April 4, 2007.

Two reputable contract companies submitted competitive bids for this contract (See "Exhibit B"). The engineer's estimate for this project was \$149,837.75. The lowest bid for this project was submitted by Midwestern Electric, Inc. at \$193,413.35.

The Westfield Public Works Department and HNTB staff has reviewed the Midwestern Electric, Inc. contract and supplemental information and have determined that Midwestern Electric, Inc. has met the requirements as defined in the contract documents.

Therefore, the Westfield Public Works Department recommends to the Westfield Town Council that the contract amount of \$193, 413.35 be awarded to Midwestern Electric, Inc. for construction of the 147th Street and Greyhound Pass Intersection Improvements.
