The Westfield Town Council met in special session Thursday, June 28, 2007 at the Westfield Town Hall. Council reached consensus that the intersection of Western Way and 146<sup>th</sup> Street be redesigned as presented by HNTB. Additionally, consensus was met regarding not reconstructing Greyhound Pass as it was originally part of the Western Way scope of work and construction. However, the Council requested further information to be presented regarding this stretch of thoroughfare for future considerations.



President Cook and Westfield Town Council,

Thank you for listening to our concerns regarding parking problems at our February 15 meeting.

The Downtown Westfield Neighborhood Association met yesterday, April 10, to review the proposed parking plan (attached). DWNA discussed this proposal and its effect on downtown merchants for about one hour. At the conclusion of that discussion we voted and received unanimous agreement in favor of your plan with the following suggested changes:

1. We request that the new plan does not eliminate any existing downtown parking spaces.
2. We request that the following areas have a four-hour parking limit: North Union Street between Main Street and Penn Street, PLUS the first four spaces on the south side of Penn just east of Union Street.
3. We request that the Town of Westfield install a sidewalk or walking path on town property located on North Union, approximately adjacent to the Penn Street intersection, to the municipal parking lot at the trailhead of Asa Bales Park.
4. We request these parking requirements run Monday morning through noon Saturday.
5. We understand that there will be no parking from 2:00 a.m. - 6:00 a.m. daily to allow for street maintenance.


Thank you again for listening and responding to our concerns. We look forward to the adoption of this new plan/ordinance.

### Sec. 58-354.1 Parking Zones Restrictions (SR 32)

#### NOTICE OF OFFICIAL ACTION

OF


#### INDIANA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

Whereas, under and by virtue of the Statues of the State of Indiana relative to traffic regulation, the Indiana Department of Transportation has the authority and the duty to adopt and promulgate in the interest of safety and convenience of the traveling public using highways, including streets in cities and town, under the control of said department, be it known the following traffic regulations (restrictions) is hereby adopted:

Parking restrictions shall be established on SR 32 in Westfield, Indiana, Hamilton County as follows:

- (1) *Two Hour Parking* shall be established on the north and south side of SR 32 for marked parking spaces between the east corners of Mill and Westlea Streets on SR 32 to the west corners of Cherry Street on SR 32.
- (2) In the area described above and depicted in Exhibit "A", *Two Hour Parking* will be enforced between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. EST, Monday-Sunday. Between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. EST, *No Parking* will be permitted.
