The Downtown Westfield Neighborhood Association (“DWNA”) is excited to announce Westfield’s inaugural art festival “Numa”. The festival will be held September 13th and 14th, 2008. The name “Numa” came from the second Roman King, Numa Pompilius. During his 43 year reign, he was conversant in divine and human law and known for his justice and piety. Numa, was a proponent of peace, making treaties with his neighbors, and taking every opportunity intimating that the arts and study of peace. Numa was also responsible for changing the, then existing, 10 month calendar to a 12 month calendar. September, our festival month, became the ninth month. A model of culture and how that can be incorporated in to community involvement, Numa became our festival namesake.

The Numa committee is a subcommittee of the DWNA. We are non-for-profit, operating on sponsorships and contributions. The sponsorships range from \$ 20,000 to \$ 500. This money is managed by the DWNA finance committee.

Kurt Wanninger is on our committee and will assist with the presentation.




