

- Highlights for the Regulation of Sales

- Only in specific types of buildings – not tents or other temporary structures
- Only in business districts
- Requiring fire extinguishers
- Storage and sales must be within the store – no temporary or portable storage units
- License from State and City required



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
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- License Requirements

- Operator's Contact information
- Emergency Contacts
- Proof of State Permit
- Proof of Insurance
- Term of six months or store closing, whichever occurs first
 - Limited to two per calendar year
 - May be applied for after June 1st of each year

- Penalties

- Five (5) day period to address any violations
- Failure to comply or violation of any license condition shall result in a one (1) year suspension



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- Anticipated Schedule for Adoption

- Council meets the second Monday of each month
 - Optional meeting night is the fourth Monday
- April 6 – submit to City Council
- April 13 – first reading
- April 27 or May 11 – second reading and adoption
- Does not appear before the Advisory Plan Commission
