

## **Recognition of Westfield's Storm Water Program**

The City of Westfield Public Works Department would like to take this opportunity to inform the Board of Public Works and Safety of a recent recognition that the City of Westfield has obtained in regards to the City's Storm Water Program.

On April 30, 2009, IDEM held the Annual MS4 (Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems) Meeting at the Hamilton County Fairgrounds. During that meeting, some of the local MS4's were recognized for the quality of their storm water programs. Westfield was one of the MS4s recognized with a "Certificate of Recognition for implementation of the MS4 Storm Water Quality Management Plan Associated with Program Management, Public Education & Outreach, Public Participation & Involvement, Municipal Facility Pollution Prevention & Good Housekeeping."

The City of Westfield were one of 12 MS4s to receive recognition out of 32 MS4s who had been audited (There are 49 total MS4s). Carmel, Fishers and Cicero also received recognition within Hamilton County.
