Action Item #4 – Bid Approval – Monon Trail Phase II 156th Street to 161st Street

The Westfield Parks Department accepted bids for the construction of the Monon Trail from 156th Street to 161st Street.

The Monon Trail project consists of the conversion of an abandon railroad to a multi-use trail. Work activities consist of some clearing, pedestrian guardrail installation, retaining wall installation, and a 12' wide asphalt trail.

The bids based upon the unit costs are:

Funding for this project will be funded through the State Trail Grant Program. The City of Westfield has been allocated the total cost for this project.

The Westfield Public Works Department Engineering Division staff has reviewed the bids for this contract and supplemental information submitted by the bidders. The Westfield Public Works Department Engineering Division recommends awarding the contract, not to exceed the base bid, to **Yardberry Landscaping**.
