# Westfield Police Department Straight and Overtime Hours Worked August 2009






# Westfield Police Department Straight and Overtime Hours Worked 2009 Year-to-Date






# Westfield Police Department Straight and Overtime Hours Worked 2009 Year-to-Date




# Westfield Police Department Straight and Overtime Hours Worked 2009 Year-to-Date

**Grand Junction Derby** – August 9<sup>th</sup>, Officer Bays, Taylor, and Larrison participated in the Grand Junction Derby.


