

ORDINANCE NUMBER 07-15

**AN AMENDMENT OF ORDINANCE 07-09 OF THE TOWN OF WESTFIELD
TO ESTABLISH COMPLIANCE WITH THE TOWN THOROUGHFARE PLAN AND
STATE OF
INDIANA U.S.31 PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Town of Westfield, Indiana, hereinafter "Town", is a duly formed municipal corporation within the State of Indiana, hereinafter, "State", governed by the Town Council, hereinafter "Council", has the duty, responsibility and authority to establish, monitor, and maintain ordinances for the general safety and welfare of the public as well as foster good economic growth for the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to aid and foster this orderly and planned growth by aiding the State in their project by requiring development to be compliant with the Project so as not to unnecessarily require the relocation of businesses and persons; and,

WHEREAS, a failure to attempt to safeguard the proposed rights of way would only unnecessarily increase the acquisition costs for the implementation of the Thoroughfare Plan of the Town and the Project by the State that would be a detriment to all as well as allow for the unnecessary dislocation of persons and businesses; and,

WHEREAS, the Town has become aware that the State of Indiana has benefited from the notification procedures adopted in Ordinance 07-09 and has requested similar provisions for the State Road 32 Overlay Zone within Washington Township as well; and,

WHEREAS, after being fully advised in the matter,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE WESTFIELD TOWN
COUNCIL THAT:**

SECTION I.

This Ordinance shall apply to any person or entity proposing development within the area designated as the State Road 32 Overlay Zone as described within the Westfield-Washington Zoning Ordinance.

SECTION II.

Said person or entity shall be required to send notice of the proposed development to the State of Indiana by registered mail at the time of the initial filing with the Town.

SECTION III.

The Community Development Director is hereby ordered to provide for the amendment of the rules and procedures that must be addressed in carrying out this Ordinance and to create a document to be forwarded to the State for any development within the State Road 32 Overlay Zone.

SECTION IV.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect in accordance with Indiana law, upon the passage of any applicable waiting periods, all as provided by the laws of the State of Indiana. All ordinances or parts thereof that are in conflict herewith are hereby ordered repealed.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF WESTFIELD
TO ESTABLISH COMPLIANCE WITH THE TOWN THOROUGHFARE PLAN AND STATE OF
INDIANA U.S.31 PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Town of Westfield, Indiana, hereinafter "Town", is a duly formed municipal corporation within the State of Indiana, hereinafter, "State", governed by the Town Council, hereinafter "Council", has the duty, responsibility and authority to establish, monitor, and maintain ordinances for the general safety and welfare of the public as well as foster good economic growth for the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Council to improve the health, safety, convenience, and welfare of their citizens and to plan for the future orderly development and growth of their communities by enhancing the roadways system under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Council is aware of the State's plans to expand and /or relocate and/or otherwise enhance the right of way for the U.S. 31 corridor as an additional means to enhance the roadway system for use of the citizens of the State, hereinafter, "Project", pursuant to plans adopted by the State; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to aid and foster this orderly and planned growth by aiding the State in their project by requiring development to be compliant with the Project so as not to unnecessarily require the relocation of businesses and persons; and,

WHEREAS, a failure to attempt to safeguard the proposed rights of way would only unnecessarily increase the acquisition costs for the implementation of the Thoroughfare Plan of the Town and the Project by the State that would be a detriment to all as well as allow for the unnecessary dislocation of persons and businesses; and,

WHEREAS, the Town has recently adopted a Thoroughfare Plan as a means to plan for the orderly movement of traffic and persons throughout the planning jurisdiction of the Town; and,

WHEREAS, requiring development to be consistent with both the Project of the State and the Thoroughfare Plan of the Town is in the best interests of the citizens of the Town and those served by the planning and zoning of the Town by requiring orderly growth of and the expansion of roadways; and,

WHEREAS, after being fully advised in the matter,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE WESTFIELD TOWN COUNCIL THAT:

SECTION I. This Ordinance shall require that the Westfield-Washington Zoning Ordinance be amended to include that all development within the Town's planning area shall be required to comply with the Westfield-Washington Thoroughfare Plan.

SECTION II. This Ordinance shall require that any development taking place within the area designated as the U.S 31 Overlay Zone as described within the Westfield-Washington Zoning Ordinance, be required to send notice of any proposed development to the State of Indiana by registered mail of said development at the time of the initial filing with the Town of Westfield.

SECTION III. The Community Development Director is hereby ordered to provide for the amendment of the rules and procedures that must be addressed in carrying out this Ordinance and to create a document to be forwarded to the State for any development within the U.S 31 Overlay Zone.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect in accordance with Indiana law, upon the passage of any applicable waiting periods, all as provided by the laws of the State of Indiana. All ordinances or parts thereof that are in conflict herewith are hereby ordered repealed.

PETITION HISTORY

The Advisory Plan Commission held a public hearing on this petition at the April 23, 2007 APC hearing. The public hearing was conducted in accordance with statute. The Advisory Plan Commission voted to send a favorable recommendation to the Town Council.

PROCEDURAL

Notice of this proposed ordinance was published in newspapers of general circulation in accordance with applicable State statutes (minimum of 10 days prior to hearing).

Notice provided to newspapers of general circulation failed to meet Westfield-Washington legal notice standards (minimum of 21 days prior to hearing). The Advisory Plan Commission waived this requirement, and the request was heard at the April 23, 2007 hearing.

Copies of the proposed text amendment have been made available to the public, the reviewing committees, subcommittees, and elected officials in advance of the published hearing date.

SUMMARY

This proposed ordinance would require any new development in Westfield and Washington Township to comply with the recommendations of the Westfield Thoroughfare Plan, adopted by resolution of the Westfield Town Council on April 9, 2007 (Ordinance 07-08).

The proposed ordinance would further provide for the Indiana Department of Transportation to receive a notice of any proposed development within the US 31 Corridor. In addition, the ordinance instructs the Community Development Department to create any and all necessary forms and proposed revisions to any applicable rules and procedures to accomplish this notification.

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the proposed ordinance as presented.
