

Dear Homeowner,

The City of Westfield has been made aware of problems with speeding vehicles in your neighborhood. We are writing you to make you aware of this situation, outline what the city will be doing to help in a solution, and to ask for your help.

Your Homeowners Association has received complaints from residents about speeding. The association has asked for the Westfield Police Department to partner with you in trying to eliminate the problem in your neighborhood.

Later this week the Westfield Police Department will place a "Your Speed Is" signboard on a main thoroughfare in your addition. The purpose of this sign is to make residents and visitors aware of how fast they are actually travelling as they move through the neighborhood as compared to the posted speed. The signboard will be out for at least three business days.

The next step will be to put Westfield Police Department officers in your addition to conduct targeted speed enforcement. They will be writing tickets to violators; persons receiving tickets can expect to spend time in court, pay fines and court costs, and to have points assessed to their drivers' licenses which can impact insurance costs.

Speeding cars in your neighborhood affect your quality of life. They endanger your children and family members, upset residents and visitors, and make your area a less desirable place to be. We want to help you enjoy your neighborhood and your city- please help us make that happen!
