


Westfield Fire Department 2009 Incident Statistics By Fire / Medical Groups




Westfield Fire Department 2008 Total Incidents

Westfield Fire Department 2009 Incidents by Fire/Medical






Westfield Fire Department 2009 Fire/Medical Incidents By Governmental Area








Westfield Fire Department 2008 Total Incidents

Westfield Fire Department 2009 Incidents by Fire/Medical






Westfield Fire Department 2009 Fire/Medical Incidents By Governmental Area





Re: WFD Year In Review

The following is a synopsis of activities and benchmarks within WFD during 2009:

- No major injuries or death to WFD personnel
- Hosted WFD Heritage Day
- Awarded Division Chief Pamela Taylor Attitude of Servitude award at Chamber of Commerce Lantern Awards Banquet
- Hired and trained four recruit firefighters (3 new positions, 1 replacement)
- Chief Burtron was a presenter at the Indiana Parks & Recreation annual conference
- Grant Funding:

- Facilities
 - Began formal process for Station 83 construction

 - Began development process for City of Westfield Public Safety Training Facility
 - Replaced one of three boilers for HVAC
 - Replaced/updated exterior illumination for PSB
- Public Education
 - First Annual City of Westfield Safety Festival
 - Smoke Detector Blitz
 - Provided education to **4552** people in structured formats (**2828** children, **1724** adults)
- EMS Billing
 - Outsourced EMS billing to increase collections efficiency and avoid the need to hire additional administrative assistant in the near future.
 - EMS cost recovery for 2009: **\$497,545.00** billed, **\$83,169.00** contractually written off, **\$376,931.40** deposited.
- Training
 - 13 personnel attended the National Fire Academy in Emmitsburg, Maryland. Prior to this year attendance at the NFA was an untapped training resource. The training provided by the NFA is free to the City along with reimbursed travel expenses. This year we committed 114 man-days away from home (**2736** man-hours) which includes **976** hours of classroom learning.
 - Total annual training hours (other than NFA): **16,572.62** comprised of EMS, Fire, Technical rescue, Hazmat, Department Operations, etc...
 - 46 ½ % increase in training hours from 2008 to 2009.
- Westfield READY
 - Continued development of the program
 - Placed Mobile Command Post in service for Citywide use
 - Conducted the only municipally organized H1N1 Clinic in Hamilton County administering **572** total vaccines

- In partnership with Hamilton County Health Department we conducted a Full Scale Training Exercise simulating a mass prophylaxis event.
- Developed, for the first time ever, an electronic risk assessment map. This map is the fruition of training received at the NFA and collaboration with Informatics department
- Further developed CERT (Community Emergency Response Team)
- Operations
 - Total number of emergency incidents: **2043** (1410 EMS, 633 Fire) a 9.3 % decrease from 2008.
 - Began process to equip Engines 81 & 82 with Advanced Life Support equipment
 - In partnership with Washington Township: purchased emergency ATV to be used for emergency incidents along trail network, parks, and community events
 - Began formal process of design of Engine 83




Westfield Fire Department 2009 Incident Statistics By Fire / Medical Groups




Westfield Fire Department 2008 Total Incidents






Westfield Fire Department 2009 Fire/Medical Incidents By Governmental Area

Westfield Fire Department 2009 Incidents by Governmental Areas






