


Rotary Sensory Garden at Freedom Trails Park of Westfield

The intention is to develop a sensory garden and educational area for all ages. The garden would include the following areas:

- Sensory Sampler – This area is the first phase of the sensory garden, to be completed in 2010. This area will include plantings selected to provide an educational experience centered around the senses.
- Prairie Area – This area would include mowed walking trails, educational signage, and potentially benches or seating areas.
- Arboretum – This area would include mulched trails through the wooded area on the northwest side of the Freedom Trails Park. There would be educational signage and seating areas.
- Water Area/Feature – This area is the least defined at this point, but preliminary thoughts include a small “pond”, a waterfall, and numerous boulders. Educational signage and seating will be placed throughout the area.
- Music/Sound Garden – This area will include bamboo, wind chimes and other hardscapes that will be used to interact with the sense of sound.
- Shelter Area – The committee has been researching installing a special soft floor in a portion of the floor of the shelter to allow for therapy to occur on site.
