

Westside Interceptor Sewer Construction in a Floodway Mitigation Monitoring Contract

The City of Westfield Public Works Department is requesting that the Board of Public Works and Safety consider the following contract for services for the monitoring of the construction in a floodway mitigation site associated with the Westside Interceptor Sewer. HNTB was the original design engineering firm for the Westside Interceptor Sewer and designed the construction in a floodway mitigation that was installed as part of the Westside Interceptor Sewer Project.

As part of the is Construction in a Floodway Mitigation, the Indiana Department of Natural Resources requires that this mitigation area be monitored for three (3) years and detailed reporting be submitted in order to verify that the migration area has been established over this three (3) year period. The Mitigation Monitoring is described in Attachment A of the Contract for Services.

At the April 1, 2010 meeting the board discussed the HNTB proposal of \$44,500 to complete the monitoring project and requested additional proposals from other qualified companies. The following list contains four additional proposals with the company and total cost listed:

- American Structurepoint, Inc. \$17,461.00
- Christopher B. Burke Engineering LTD \$24,200.00
- Bernardin, Lochmueller & Assoc.,Inc. \$35,700.00

The total compensation for these services over the three (3) year period, which includes expenses, will not exceed \$_____. In year one (1), 2010, the remaining bond proceeds will be utilized to pay this expenditure. In years two (2) and three (3), this expenditure will be budgeted into the Annual Budget for the Wastewater Utility.

Therefore, the Westfield Public Works Department Recommends to the Board of Public Works Department to authorize the Public Works Director to execute the agreement for Contractual Services for the Westside Interceptor Sewer IDNR Construction in a Floodway Mitigation Site Monitoring Services.
