

156th Street Small Structure Replacement Project – Bid Award

The City of Westfield Public Works Department is requesting that the Board of Public Works and Safety consider the following bids for consideration and make a recommendation for award.

This project consists of removing the existing lane and half 3-sided box culvert and installing a new hydraulically sized conspan arch structure with timber guide rail features. This project will be funded out of the City of Westfield's Stormwater Fund. This bridge is listed in the top 8 for replacement according to the City of Westfield Small Structure Inventory List. This segment of road will be closed for 90 days.

Following is the proposed schedule for the East Access Road:

- Board of Public Works Thursday 9/2
- Precon & Utility Coordination Friday 9/3
- Contractor Mobilization Monday 9/13 (tentative)
