ORDINANCE NO. 10- 12

AN ORDINANCE BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTFIELD TO AUTHORIZE JURISDICTION TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY

WHEREAS, the City of Westfield (“City”) is governed by its duly elected Mayor and Common Council (“Council”) and is charged with the duties to maintain efficient and effective processes in the administration of services provided to the citizens of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Westfield has become the City of Westfield, the Board of Public Works and Safety (“BPW”) has been established pursuant to statute; and,

WHEREAS, IC 36-1-3-6 grants municipalities the power to operate and govern local affairs by adopting ordinances prescribing the specific manner in which said power is to be exercised:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF WESTFIELD, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That certain ordinances adopted by the Town and City have provisions within to allow for appeals to the Town/City Council in the case of matters within the jurisdiction of the Board of Public Works. These ordinances include but are not limited to appeals from fines related to illegal sanitary sewer discharges and discharges into the storm water sewer system.

Section 2. That the creation of the BPW allows for a more efficient and effective management of the issues related to the Board of Public Works and as such, should and is now declared to be the proper entity to hear reviews and appeals related to issues from the Board of Public Works as provided by ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall remain in force until later amended or repealed by the Council.





All ordinances or parts thereof that are in conflict herewith are hereby ordered repealed. Any portion of this Ordinance later deemed invalid shall not operate to invalidate the remaining portions. All acts undertaken to establish this Ordinance are hereby ratified.




