RE: Request for Time Extension to the Rules of Procedure

Dear Mr. Todd:

Please let this letter serve as our formal request to an extension of time for the Symphony PUD petition currently before the Westfield Advisory Plan Commission. The public hearing for this petition occurred on June 21, 2010. Per the Plan Commission's Rules of Procedure, no continuances are allowed past a date six months from when the public hearing occurred. We are currently revising the Symphony PUD ordinance and illustrative plan to address the levels of specificity and certainty desired by the Plan Commission.

In the midst of making these changes we discovered that the Hamilton County Commissioners are considering modifications to the alignment of the 146th Street at the Ditch Road intersection. Given the importance of this intersection, we would like to establish with better certainty the route of 146th Street before finalizing the land plan and PUD ordinance for Symphony.

We believe these issues will be addressed and a revised version of the Symphony PUD ordinance can be back in front of the Plan Commission for action within 90 days of the expiration date specified in the Rules of Procedure.
