

Presentation Item - 2011 Snow Removal Policy

The Westfield Public Works Department is presenting the 2011 City of Westfield Snow Removal Policy to the Board of Public Works and Safety.

This Snow Removal Policy will assist the Westfield Public Works Department in the event of adverse weather conditions associated with winter precipitation. This policy also aids the public in being prepared for the measures that will be implemented by the Public Works Department and provides valuable information to answer some of the frequently asked questions.

The Public Works Department has prepared for the potential winter conditions that may be presented during this winter as all equipment and supplies have been prepared and serviced. The Public Works has 4 Tandem Trucks, 2 Single Axle Truck, 21 Pick-ups, one Pay Loader, 2 Rubber tired Backhoes, 2 Bobcats, 2 Kawasaki Mules, 1 John Deere Gator, and one Massey Ferguson Tractor with a Snow Blower attachment for the removal of snow.

Currently, the Public Works Department has approximately 1200 tons of salt in the City of Westfield Salt Storage Facility. Additionally, pursuant to the collaborative salt contract with the other Hamilton County Municipal agencies, the City has 3000 tons of salt at their disposal for road treatment.
