

In consideration of Bike It permitting me or my minor child to participate in Bike It event or activities. I, the undersigned, for myself and my heirs, next of kin, assign, and personal representative, do hereby agree to the following.

1. I understand that bicycling require physical conditioning and I represent that I am in sound medical condition capable of participating in Bike It events, rides, and activities without risk to myself or others. I have no know medical impediment, which would endanger others or myself. I agree that I will be solely responsible for the condition and adequacy of my bicycle, safety gear, and riding equipment and the riding conditions and in a manner so as not to endanger either others or myself.
2. I understand that my name, address, photograph, voice and/or likeness may be used in promotional or advertising materials. I consent to such uses and waive any rights of privacy or publicity I may have in connection with those uses.
3. I understand that bicycle riding is potentially hazardous activity, which involves risk, inherent, and otherwise, known or unknown, that cannot be eliminated which may cause injury, illness, paralysis or death to myself, other persons, and/or damage to property. I further understand that negligence of Bike It, including its officers, members, volunteers, and sponsors, any member of the Shelby family, The Prostate Cancer Foundation, The City of Westfield, DWNA and the Westfield Washington Schools, its employees, board members, and volunteers, or other risks associated with Bike It events or activities may cause injury, illness, paralysis or death to myself, other persons, and/or damage to property. Some of the risks associated with Bike It events, rides, and activities include, but are not limited to equipment failure, collisions with other riders, terrain object, or vehicles, and known or unknown medical conditions. I assume full and sole responsibility for all risk, both known and unknown, inherent or otherwise, related to the Bike It events, rides and activities. Further, I am voluntarily participating in this activity with knowledge of the risks and fully accept and assume all risks related to or arising from Bike It events, rides, and activities.
4. Acknowledging that such risk exist, I PERSONALLY AND ON BEHALF OF MY MINOR CHILD, HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE, AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE BIKE IT, ITS OFFICERS, OFFICIALS, MEMBERS, VOLUNTEERS, AND SPONSORS, and the officers, directors, employees, representative, agents, insurers, and successors of all the above (hereinafter individually and collectively referred to as the "Releases") from any and all claims, damages, losses, actions, suits, proceedings, breach of contract actions, wrongful death actions, expenses, attorney fees, and liability that I, anyone on my behalf, my heirs, next of kin of minor child might have for or relating to any injury, including death to my person or that of my minor child or property suffered or claimed to have been suffered by me which arises out of or is related in any manner, either directly or indirectly, to my or my minor child's participation in any Bike It Event, ride or activity or my assistance at any Bike It event, ride or activity, including, but not limited to, any claim that the act or omission complained of was caused in whole or in part by the negligence in any form of the Releases.
5. I further agree to INDEMNIFY, HOLD HARMLESS, AND DEFEND in any action or proceeding Releases against all claims, lawsuits, losses, damages, actions, suites, proceedings, claims, and expenses, including attorney's fees and costs arising from or relating in any respect to my or my minor child's participation in any Bike It event, ride or activity or my assistance at any Bike It events, ride or activity or my breach of this agreement regardless of whether the act or omission complained of was caused in whole or in part by the negligence in any form of the Releasees Bike It Volunteers have no duty to indemnify, defend or hold harmless the Releasees.
6. This document is governed by the laws by the state of Indiana. If one or more portions of this document are found unenforceable, the remainder of the document will remain enforceable. If I am a minor, my parent or guardians also signing individually and on my behalf and we both agree to be bound by the terms of this agreement.

I have read and fully understand this Waiver and Release of Liability and indemnify Agreement and agree to be bound to its terms. I understand that by signing this document i may be waiving certain legal rights, including the right to sue Bike It or any of the Releasees. I have read this document and sign this document freely and willingly.
