### WHAT'S SO GRAND?

Grand Park is a thoughtfully designed sports campus that will feature a full range of championship-level outdoor facilities for baseball, softball and field sports

including soccer, football, rugby, field hockey and lacrosse along with a multi-purpose indoor facility, common areas and green space. The fields will be surrounded by dining, retail and entertainment venues, all geared toward supporting and enhancing the family sports atmosphere and experience.

Over 250,000 sports visitors are expected to participate in or attend

events at the facility annually. Building on the state of Indiana's long and storied sports tradition, Grand Park will be a premier location for athletes, visitors and the local community alike. Sports visitors in Hamilton County spend \$5 million each year to local businesses and Westfield's Grand Park is sure to enhance that visitor spending ultimately attracting new businesses to the area.

## GRAND JUNCTION

The Grand Junction in downtown Westfield is emerging as a dynamic plan to memorialize the history and celebrate the future of the City of Westfield. The dream is becoming a reality as the first phase of construction began in May 2010. The Grand Junction area is planned at the southeast corner of SR32 and South Union Street.

## EAST ACCESS ROAD ON SCHEDULE

The East Access Road - running behind the Marsh and Walmart in Westfield - includes a new road, roundabout and entrance to Cool Creek Park. Work is set to be completed by October 10, 2011.

## US 31 PROJECT UNDERWAY IN WESTFIELD

Construction is underway in Westfield which will upgrade US 31 to freeway standards. The 146th Street Bridge will be under construction from April to just before the 2011 holiday season. The SR 38 interchange will be the first interchange constructed. Work on the interchange began in spring 2011 and will take approximately two years to complete.

## MONON TRAIL STATUS UPDATE

The newest section of the Monon Trail is now open! The Monon now runs from 146th Street to Oak Ridge Road and connects to Quaker Park.



## HISTORIC YAP SIGNING

House Bill 1107 allows county juvenile court judges to establish the voluntary Youth Assistance Program within their jurisdictions. Created here in Westfield, it is important because reaching at-risk youth with early intervention helps produce productive citizens, ultimately keeping them out of the criminal court systems.
