CITY'S TRANSPORTATION PLAN

The City of Westfield has big plans for the expansion of the Monon and Midland Trace Trails and additional roundabouts and road projects to help with traffic flow. First of all, the Monon Trail bridge over 146th Street will begin construction this fall. This is a Hamilton County project and should be completed by next summer. The City plans to extend the Monon Trail all the way to Sheridan. In addition to the Monon expansion, the Midland Trace Trail will also be expanded west to Gray Road over the next two years.



Here is the planned construction timeline:

Monon Trail

- Paving the Monon Trail from 161st Street to SR 32 – 2012
- Construction from SR32 to Monon Trail Elementary School – 2013 (currently in negotiations w/ INDOT for overpass over State Road 32 as part of the US31 freeway project)
- Monon Trail Elementary School to 216th Street - 2014 – part of a joint City-County partnership

Midland Trace Trail

- Carey Road to Gunther Blvd – 2012
- Gunther Blvd to Gray Road – 2013

CITY'S TRANSPORTATION PLAN (CONTINUED)

The City also plans to build several roundabouts and roads throughout the city. Here is the planned schedule and locations for construction:

Roads

- East Access Road (Cool Creek Park Road) – completed November 2011
- West Access Road from S. Union Street to 151st Street – 2013
- West Access Road from 151st Street to Western Way – 2014
- 161st Street bridge – 2013 (county project)

Roundabouts

- 161st Street and Oak Ridge Road – 2013
- 156th Street and Spring Mill Road – 2014
- 161st Street and Carey Road – 2014
