NEW DEVELOPMENT BEGINS IN DOWNTOWN WESTFIELD

Union Street Flats at Grand Junction will consist of a total of 19 buildings which will contain 237 residential units. This unique location on Union Street, just north of 171st Street, sets this development adjacent to many historical homes and community landmarks. Union Street Flats is designed as a neo-traditional neighborhood that incorporates the historical architecture along Union Street with a pedestrian friendly neighborhood within walking distance to the activity of downtown Westfield.

The property will serve as a trail head for the Anna Kendall Trail and will offer pedestrians and bikers a place to relax and enjoy the environmentally preserved surroundings. The Anna Kendall Trail will be extended through the Union Street Flats property and will allow residents immediate access to one of the finest trail systems in the Midwest. Union Street Flats

residents will be able to take a short walk or bike ride to enjoy the shopping, dining and entertainment options available downtown.


PLANT-A-ROW FOR THE HUNGRY
