US 31 CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

As some commuters have already noticed, INDOT recently closed off access to vehicles attempting to access US 31 from 161st Street. This closure is one of many challenges facing Westfield commuters over the next several months. The 161st Street closure began mid-April and is expected to last 120 days, before reopening as a double roundabout intersection bridge.

In addition to the 161st Street closure, motorists are no longer able to turn left from US 31 between 151st and 169th Streets. However, left turns are permitted at 151st and 169th Streets. These left turns are permanently eliminated as part of the new freeway design.

Construction planned for 2013, includes the extension of East Street north to 196th Street which will allow traffic to access US 31 while 191st Street intersection receives an upgrade in 2014. Crews will also begin work on the 151st Street and Greyhound Pass intersections as they will run underneath the upgraded US 31. Improvements to US 31 between 146th Street and 169th Street are to be completed by 2014.

Beginning in 2014, work will begin between 169th Street and 196th Street – including the SR 32 intersection. Currently, INDOT expects US 31 improvements to be completed through Westfield by 2015. For more information and current construction schedules, visit www.US31HamiltonCounty.in.gov
