

CITY COUNCIL UPDATE

Approval of Animal Control Contract

The city requested the amount of \$48,896.05 be paid to the Humane Society of Hamilton County to cover the costs of stray/owner surrendered animals by residents and police officers.

Amendment to the Traffic Regulation Ordinance

The following changes were presented in an attempt to provide more consistent speed limits for motorists entering the City's borders. They will be eligible for consideration October 14.

- Increase the speed limit of 151st Street from Gray to Carey roads from 30 mph to 40 mph
- Increase the speed limit of 169th Street from Gray to Carey roads from 30 mph to 40 mph
- Decrease the speed limit of 156th Street from Oakridge to Towne roads from 50 mph to 45 mph
- Decrease the speed limit of Ditch Road from 146th Street to Ind. 32 from 50 mph to 45 mph
- Decrease the speed limit of Spring Mill Road from 146th Street to Ind. 32 from 45 mph to 40 mph

GRAND JUNCTION IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

Last month, the Westfield City Council approved the Grand Junction Implementation Plan. The plan is a compilation of past reports and works and is intended to refine previous addendums to the Westfield-Washington Township Comprehensive Plan.



The Implementation Plan highlights and summarizes the major objectives while setting forth recommended action items to accomplish those objectives.
