

WESTFIELD IN LIGHTS // This year Westfield in Lights had a record breaking attendance of 3,500+ people! Every year the event continues to get better and better. Highlight attractions of this event include: Pictures with Santa, Pictures with Frosty, Carriage Rides (which sold out in 45 minutes after pre-registration opened a month prior), Train Rides, Gingerbread House Competition, Musical Entertainment preformed by local schools and church-

es, Live Reindeer, Live Nativity and finishing off the night with the tree lighting to get the Holiday Season officially kicked off!



TRAIL UPDATES

1. Grassy Branch Bridge - The new bridge over Grassy Branch connects the Monon Trail all the way to S.R. 32. A huge advantage to trail users of all kinds, this project is one stepping stone to extending the Monon all the way through Westfield's City Limits. Phast 5 (Monon over S.R. 32) & Phase 7 (Monon Elementary to 216th St) at the two final phases of the Monon through Westfield's corporate limits!
2. Monon Phase 6 - The Monon Trail has been extended from 181st Street to Monon Trail Elementary. The expansion adds 6,800 feet to the mainline Monon Trail and about 1,250 feet of connector trail along 181st Street. Signs, lighting and other items will be completed this spring. The project also includes a stub connector along 181st Street that will connect in the future to Asa Bales Park.



NEW RESTROOM AT SIMON MOON PARK!

Plans have been approved and we are now moving forward and officially under construction for a brand new year round resroom that will be located between the base of the hill and the parking lot at Simon Moon Park! (located at 2710 E 171st Street). Construction should be completed in Spring of 2016.

Park will continue to be open to patrons at this time for sledding, access to the new SMART playground, shelter, access to Midland Trace Trail, etc.
