




FILINGS OF NOTE

- **LANCASTER SUBDIVISION** was approved by Advisory Plan Commission (APC), located generally on the northwest corner of Spring Mill Road and 186th Street. This development will consist of 190 residential lots on approximately 145 acres.
- **GODDARD SCHOOL AND KIDDIE ACADEMY** are two daycare facilities approved by APC. Goddard will be an 11,000 square foot building generally at the southwest corner of SR 32 and Austrian Pine Way. Kiddie Academy will be a 10,500 square foot building generally at the northwest corner of US 31 and 191st Street.
- **STAYBRIDGE SUITES** (below) was approved by APC for an approximately 69,000 square foot hotel, with 84 rooms, located generally at the southwest corner of US 31 and 181st Street.
- **AUSTRIAN PINE PUD** was adopted by City Council, located at the southeast corner of SR 32 and Austrian Pine Way. This development contemplates 5 commercial buildings on 12.5 acres.




NOTABLE CITY EVENTS

- **Bastian Solutions**, a 90,000 square foot facility, celebrated the grand opening of the company's new advanced manufacturing facility.
- The City hosted a **Hospitality Job Fair** at the Grand Park Events Center where more than 20 area businesses provided employment opportunities.
- The City of Westfield and Hamilton County Tourism "powered up" the new **interactive kiosk** at the Monon Trailhead at East Greyhound Pass and the Monon Trail. The installment includes safety features such as surveillance, emergency dispatch, report maintenance and service requests, guided search for amenities and a photobooth.
- Mayor Andy Cook along with WPD and WPD launched Westfield's new **Safe Roads campaign**, a city-wide effort to reduce the number of personal injury and fatality automobile crashes in Westfield. The Safe Roads campaign will focus on four areas including: Education, Enforcement, Environment and Advocacy.

- ECD Community Development Coordinator Corey Harris welcomed newborn son 'Perrin Harris' to his family.


