



FILINGS OF NOTE

- **Harmony Shoppes** (*below*) was approved by the Advisory Plan Commission (APC), generally located on the northwest corner of Ditch Road and 146th Street. This development will consist of a 9,900 SF multi-tenant commercial building on approximately two acres.
- **Chatham Villages** is Phase 1 of a 147 acre residential project approved by APC. Phase 1 approved 207 single-family residential lots and is generally located west of US 31, east of Tomlinson Road, north of 196th Street and south of 203rd Street.
- **Monon Corner** was approved by APC for a 135 acre project generally located south of 206th Street and west of Horton Road. Monon Corner proposes 325 single-family residential lots as part of the Chatham Hills subdivision.
- **Haworth Business Park** is a 38 acre project generally located at the southeast corner of 169th Street and Oak Ridge Road. This project contemplates one lot and three blocks for future business uses.
