



FILINGS OF NOTE

- Several Detailed Development Plans were approved in the 2nd Quarter of the year, including: Panda Express, Sunbelt Rentals, Wheeler Landing Apartments, West Fork Whiskey Distillery, Chatham Hills Multi-family project, Valvoline, couple general commercial buildings and a 132,000 square foot industrial building.
- A few Overall Development Plans and Primary Plats for residential subdivisions were approved, including: 89 Lots in Courtyards of Westfield, 66 Lots in Chatham Hills, Sec. 6B, 151 Lots in Somerset and 403 Lots in Ackerson Farms.
- **Lantern Commons PUD** (below) was approved for a 60 acre mixed use project located at the northeast corner of 161st Street and US 31.
- A new townhome project, **Midland South PUD**, was approved for 3 acres bounded by Roosevelt Street, Cherry Street and Westfield Friends Church.
- An amendment to the **Union Square PUD** approved additional Real Estate to the existing project's location off of Union Street, east of the future Grand Junction Plaza.
- A new 28 acre PUD, **Bonterra**, was approved for a mixed use development located south of SR 32 and generally west of Gray Road.

- **Todd Burtron**, Chief of Staff for the City of Westfield, received the Credentialed Manager designation from the International City Management Association (ICMA).
- The **Westfield Police Department** released their annual report from 2020 noting a decrease in major crimes while seeing an uptick in domestic disturbances.
- On May 29, the City announced its **new splash pad** at Quaker Park opened. The new splash pad includes almost double the number of the previous splash pad.
- The Community Development Department welcomes their new Associate Planner, **Rachel Riemenschneider**.
- The mayors of Anderson, Carmel, Fishers, Noblesville and Westfield and commissioners of Hamilton and Madison County announced a regional collaboration to apply for Governor Eric Holcomb's **Indiana Regional Economic Acceleration and Development Initiative (READI)** planning grant and funding.
- Grand Park Sports Campus launched the new **Grand Park Research & Development HUB**. The HUB will serve as a center of innovation for entrepreneurs, businesses and universities that are developing new technologies, services and research projects related to facilities and activities within the sports tourism industry.
